



CHAMPIONS OHNE GRENZEN E.V. (Champion Without Borders)

CHAMPIONS ohne GRENZEN e.V. is a non-profit organisation from Berlin (Germany), which started 2012 with a weekly football training session for refugees. But from the beginning, the idea behind CHAMPIONS ohne GRENZEN was more than being a regional provider of open and cost-free sport programmes: It also acts as an agent to mediate between athletic, social and political groups of engagement. It promotes exchange and communication and identifies yet ignored fields of action in refugee policies to allow refugees to actively take part in shaping their environment. It supports its target group in making Berlin a new home. Its target group is refugees, either female or male, starting from the age of six.

Currently CHAMPIONS ohne GRENZEN runs two mixed football teams for adults, one team exclusively for women, and two different children's trainings in different areas of the City of Berlin. It also has a program called „Nachspielzeit“, which translates as “extra time” in English, to support refugees in all questions of their daily life connected to the situation during or after the asylum-process.

Currently CHAMPIONS ohne GRENZEN runs two mixed football teams for adults, one team exclusively for women, and two different children's trainings in different areas of the City of Berlin. It also has a program called „Nachspielzeit“, which translates as “extra time” in English, to support refugees in all questions of their daily life connected to the situation during or after the asylum-process. More recently it started a project “start2coach”, which aims to qualify and support refugees to take an active role in different sport clubs and trainings across Berlin. The organisation has previously also run some smaller exchange and education programmes like „Begegnung macht Schule“, in which refugees can talk and explain in schools their situation, or a guided tour through the city called „Fuss gefasst - Stadttour“.

CHAMPIONS ohne GRENZEN e.V. has co-operations with different sports clubs in the city, and it is very well connected to the local and national sports federations, as well as to many institutions of refugee aid in Berlin.

It has successfully participated in the Erasmus + Project “Kicken ohne Grezen”.
