



## UNIVERSITA' DI CASSINO

The University of Cassino (now University of Cassino and Southern Lazio) was established in 1979 as a "reference point" for the geographical area embracing southern Lazio, Campania and Molise regions. Nowadays, the University is constituted of five Departments - Law and Economics, Philosophy and Literature, Civil and Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Information Engineering, Human Sciences, Society and Health - 12,000 students, 336 Department members, 47 research units and 345 employees. Students can choose among 18 bachelor's degree programs, 14 master's degree programs, 1 five years master's degree program, 10 specialisation programs and 8 doctoral degree programs provided in Cassino and the local campus of Frosinone and Sora. The international orientation of the university focuses both on research as well as teaching activities.

The Department of Human Sciences, Society and Health was established in 2012 as an interdisciplinary group composed of Public Health and PE Scientists, Educationists, and Sociologists operating in the footsteps of the former Faculty of Sport Science.

The main fields of research are Health and Education and its determinants in modern society, with a particular focus on sports and physical activities, social inequalities in health and lifestyles, sport for all, and epidemiological methods for the evaluation of evidence-based medicine and public health.

Furthermore, the Dept. acts at the National and European levels to support the development of the Sport Science Sector by promoting a strong link between the Education and Training Providers and the Labour Market. To this purpose, the Dept. has established an educational and training system ensuring the development of a competent workforce and operating to improve the company's performance.

The Department has also set a long-established collaboration with the Italian National Olympic Committee, diverse National Sport Federations and key Organisations operating in the Sport Sector to promote collaboration among stakeholders and improve the quality and transparency of the education and training systems.
