



IV TRANSNATIONAL MEETING IN LJUBLJANA

1-2 JULY 2022

The 4th transnational meeting of the SIMCAS project took place in Ljubljana on July 1-2.

The meeting opened with the proposal of the methodological approach development and its structure, emphasizing the importance of the key elements to be identified within the guidelines. The document encloses information from the literature, research and data from each organization.

The first day continued with the sharing of local experiments and story telling videos testifying to the social activities carried out by the partners and the application of the methodological approach and guidelines.

Each video was presented according to the personality of the partners by featuring photos, music, interviews with participants and coaches or people working in the organizations.

The second working day started with the presentation of the document on sustainability in the sports sector.

The report focused on crowdfunding as an alternative source of financing for sports activities, analyzing the innovative and beneficial aspects, the main objectives of the report, case studies, conclusions, a guide for an effective project proposal starting from an analysis of the sports industry and economy in recent years.

The meeting continued with the defined proposal of the toolkit that will be available to all, translated into the local language and released on the partner website and presented in the multiplayer/transitional event.

The next item on the agenda was the proposal of the structure of the training package of the i multiplier sport events in which each partner will have to organize a workshop to disseminate the results of the project and its outputs at the national level with the aim of raising awareness, and provide a training course aimed at sports clubs wishing to increase their skills on a specific topic, for the implementation of the identified methodology.

The meeting concluded with the planning of dissemination activities and commitments for the next meetings reminding that the international event will take place in Rome in December.
